Projects INTER-PASS, SMILE, ENERMOB and INTER-CONNECT (coordinator project) formally launched Thematic Cluster on May, 15th with on-line kick-off meeting to create strong synergies in order to exchange data, information and knowledge.

Sustainable mobility in Europe is developing rapidly and an increasing amount of local communities want to take an active role in limiting the negative impacts of transport to improve the quality of life. Innovative sustainable mobility and transport solutions are aiming to meet climate change and carbon reduction goals, while a number of European projects are creating high quality technical and scientific materials.

The Thematic cluster on Urban and Interurban Low Carbon Intermodal Mobility for Passengers, the initiative of the ADRION programme, brought together partners of various ADRION projects with the common goal of capitalizing, disseminating, promoting and upgrading the results of these projects.

This ADRION Thematic Cluster began activities to highlight the results of all the sustainable mobility projects; INTER-PASS, SMILE, ENERMOB and INTER-CONNECT (cluster coordinator) formally launched Thematic Cluster No.5 on May 15th with an on-line kick-off meeting aimed at creating strong synergies in order to exchange data, information and knowledge.

INTER-CONNECT


The project follows a bottom-up approach to overcome barriers and provide improved rail-maritime based passenger intermodality. The project intends to boost intermodal put based passenger transport in ADRION through the identification of key player in mobility planning, realize of a cooperation environment, improve the common understanding and formulation of a strategic framework for enhancing intermodality.

ENERMOB

The project aim to study and support common solutions for electric transport systems at interurban and interregional level in the Adriatic-lonian macro-region, by implementing pilot networks of charging infrastructures and using common technical standards and interoperability solutions following the 2014/94/EU Directive on the deployment of alternative fuel infrastructures. The project develops pilot actions to test the interurban displacements with electric vehicles in 5 different regions.

The general objective of project is develop the intermodal connections between ports and airports in the Adriatic-Ionian Region and improve the processing of passengers, principally cruise tourists and other travelers and the specific objectives are identification and capitalization of best practices; testing of new solutions to expand and speed-up tourists between ports and airports; development of an Integrated Strategic Plan for better connections of ports and airports in Adriatic-Ionian Region.

SMILE

SMILE is focused on first and last mile of mobility in some variegated and paradigmatic urban areas of Adrion Region, embracing coastal, inland and bordering cities of different sizes. Smile'ssims to enhance policy-making capacity by the elaboration of mobility scenarios and joint transnational Sustainable Urban Mobility (SUMP) concept, support sustainable mobility in urban areas by testing IT solutions. The expected change of SMILE is multilevel: to strengthen knowledge and operational capacity about mobility of local/regional authorities; to test quick-win solutions based on IT, and to promote intermodal transport.
